

Putting Buttons into menus (this is for a Mac - check Praat-docu for Windows)

Write a Praat script (e.g. lpc_start.praat)

Put it into (~)/Library/Preferences/Praat Prefs (Disk or User Library)

Quit Praat

In the User Library, add two lines to 'Button5' in ~/Library/Preferences/Praat Prefs:

Add menu command... "SoundEditor" "View" "XXX" "" 0 /Library/Preferences/Praat Prefs/xxx.praat

Add menu command... "TextGridEditor" "View" "XXX" "" 0 /Library/Preferences/Praat Prefs/xxx.praat

(replace XXX with you file name; add “/Users/henning/” or “~” in case you use the local Library)

(The “Button5” file is read by Praat at each startup and written with each Quit.)

After starting Praat, the Button will appear in the appropriate Menu (here: “View”)
